

Locker Room Closure - U of C -KNA

As you may have heard, starting May 1, the men's and women's change rooms in KNA will be temporarily closed for an exciting upgrade! Shiny new lockers are coming soon.

Change room closure from May 1st - TBD (middle-end of June)

- During this time, there will be no access to the locker rooms from the main entrance.
- User groups will be asked to enter the pool deck from the north pool deck doors (beside guard office).
- Please remove your outdoor shoes and place them on the shoe racks right inside the door, or carry them with you and put them in your backpack. Outdoor shoes are not permitted on the pool deck.
- Groups are asked to come ready to swim with their bathing suits under their clothing. Participants may use the bleachers to put their belongings. Please ensure this area is kept tidy.
- Prior to getting into the pool, participants may access the shower area to have a quick shower. Toilets may also be accessed if required.
- Once swimming has completed, participants may use the showers to rinse off and change their clothes either in the shower stall area, the dry space located beside the steam room, or the area beside the hand dryers.
- Please exit the pool area using the same north doors.
