***Out of Province Travel:** Typically U10, 11-12, Novice and 13-15 Provincial Stream teams travel out of province to B.C., Saskatchewan or Manitoba in early May each season. We will tentatively plan to do this next season but we will need to see what the regulations are with travel in Spring of 2022 and where we are at with the pandemic. If restrictions allow and we are able to plan travel we will adjust travel fees/competition fees accordingly. Currently, travel fees listed below <u>DO NOT</u> include any out of province travel costs.

Important Training Dates

- Summer Camp 1 week Mandatory for all competitive athletes in the 11-12 age group and older (highly encouraged for all athletes)
- First Day of Training
 - August 31, 2021 (13-15 and 16-20....we will likely start these age groups August 31, Sept 1 and 2, then take the Friday through Monday off for Labour Day and continue)
 - September 7th, 2021 (11-12, Novice, U10 and Pre 10)
- Thanksgiving Weekend No training
- Winter Break Either Sunday, December 19th through Saturday, January 1st OR Monday, December 20th through Sunday, January 2nd.....depending on pool availability on the Sunday before and after the break
- Family Day Long Weekend Provincial Stream will train either the Sunday or the Monday but not both
- March 18-22 No training (long weekend off in lieu of Easter weekend No swimming Friday through Tuesday)
- Easter Weekend Provincial stream will train, No training for Pre 10 Easter Friday or Easter Monday
- Last Day of Training Thursday, May 19th, 2022
- May 24th, 2022 Optional spring training and National Team training begins



Program Information

- Team selections will be in September. Athletes will be evaluated for both water and land skills. Teams will be split according to testing results, coachability and work ethic during the team selection process
- Duet and solo practices are additional to team practices. A separate solo and duet try out will be held in September. This is an optional program. Swimmers can also choose to participate in extra figures practices at an additional cost.
- Programs will include pool and dryland sessions. Dryland sessions may include (but not limited to) flexibility training, strength, ballet, gymnastics, team landrill, sports psychology etc.
- As Artistic Swimming is a team based sport we expect swimmers to be at all practices except in cases of injury, illness or bereavement.
- There is a potential to have alternates in the 11-12 and 13-15 provincial stream programs. Coaches will have the final say in alternate selection. Alternate selection criteria will be communicated at the first team meeting of the year and reiterated throughout the season.

Members are billed for the Expenses as a straight pass-through. In addition to the Fees and Expenses, there are other related commitments related to Calgary Killarney Programming. These relate to volunteering and fundraising as outlined in the **Volunteering & Fundraising Policy found at** <u>www.yycKillarney.com</u>. **Note:** Fees and expenses do not include those costs related to extra routines or extra figures.
